- Back up generator has been ordered. Spoke to Columbia Gas engineering wants to upgrade the pipe at the street and the meter before the generator is installed. This will be no cost to the Borough. They also wanted to verify that from the property line to the meter and from the meter going into the building we have at least a 1 ¼”. McLaughlin’s verified we have a 1 ½” pipe from the street to the meter and a 1 ¼” pipe from the meter going into the building. McLaughlin’s will be using a 1 ¼” pipe to feed the generator.
